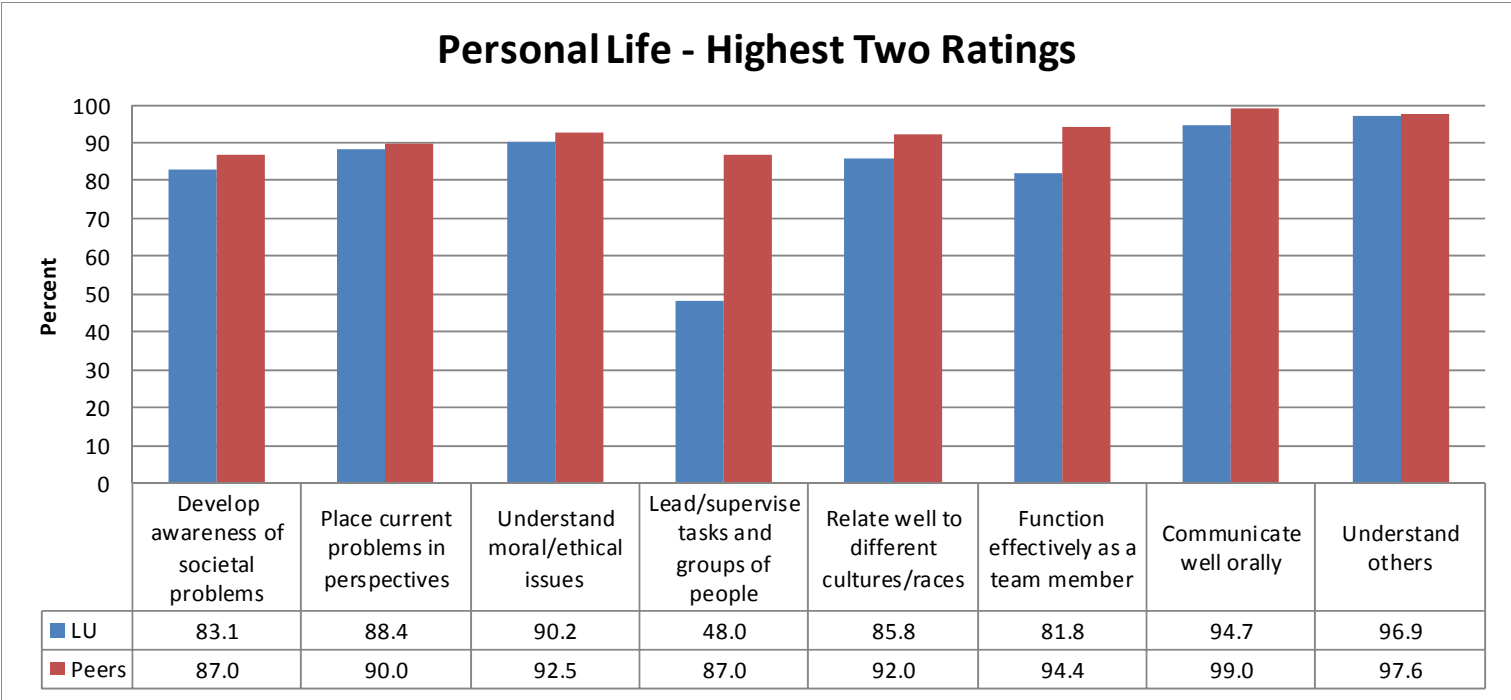
Servant Leadership at Lawrence: *A Student-centered Approach*

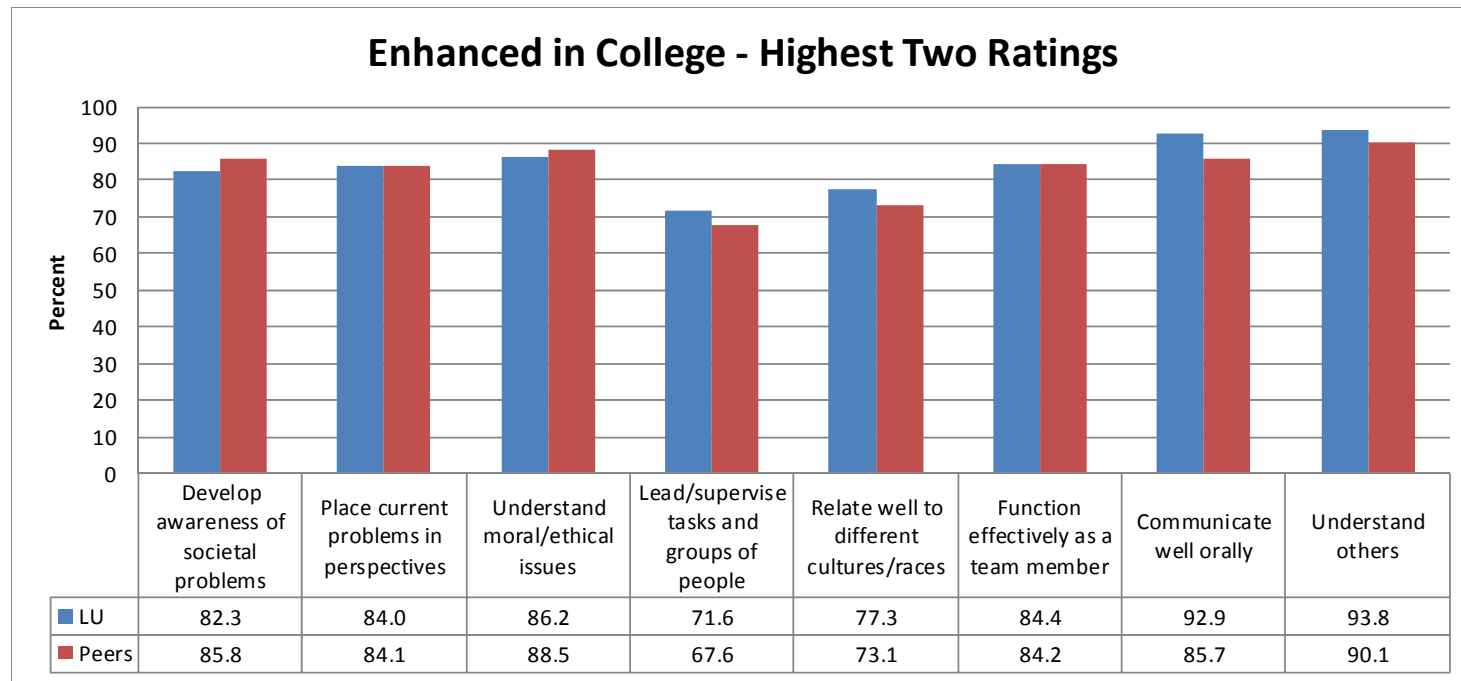

LU Alumni Compared to Alumni from Peer Institutions



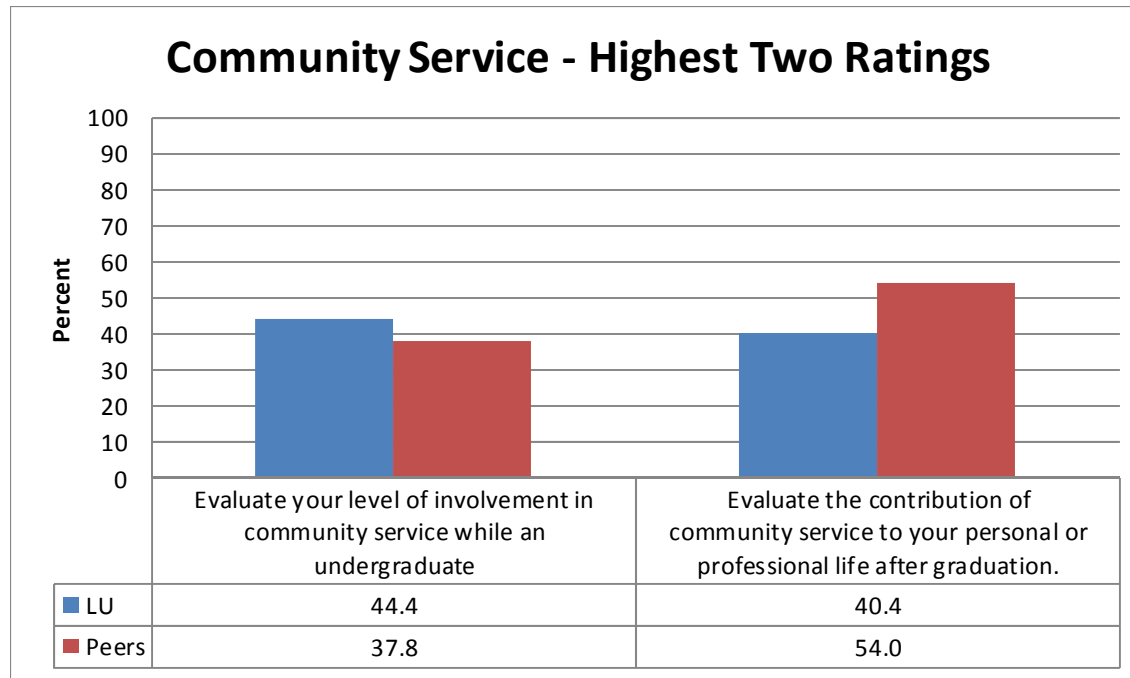

LU Alumni Compared to Alumni from Peer Institutions

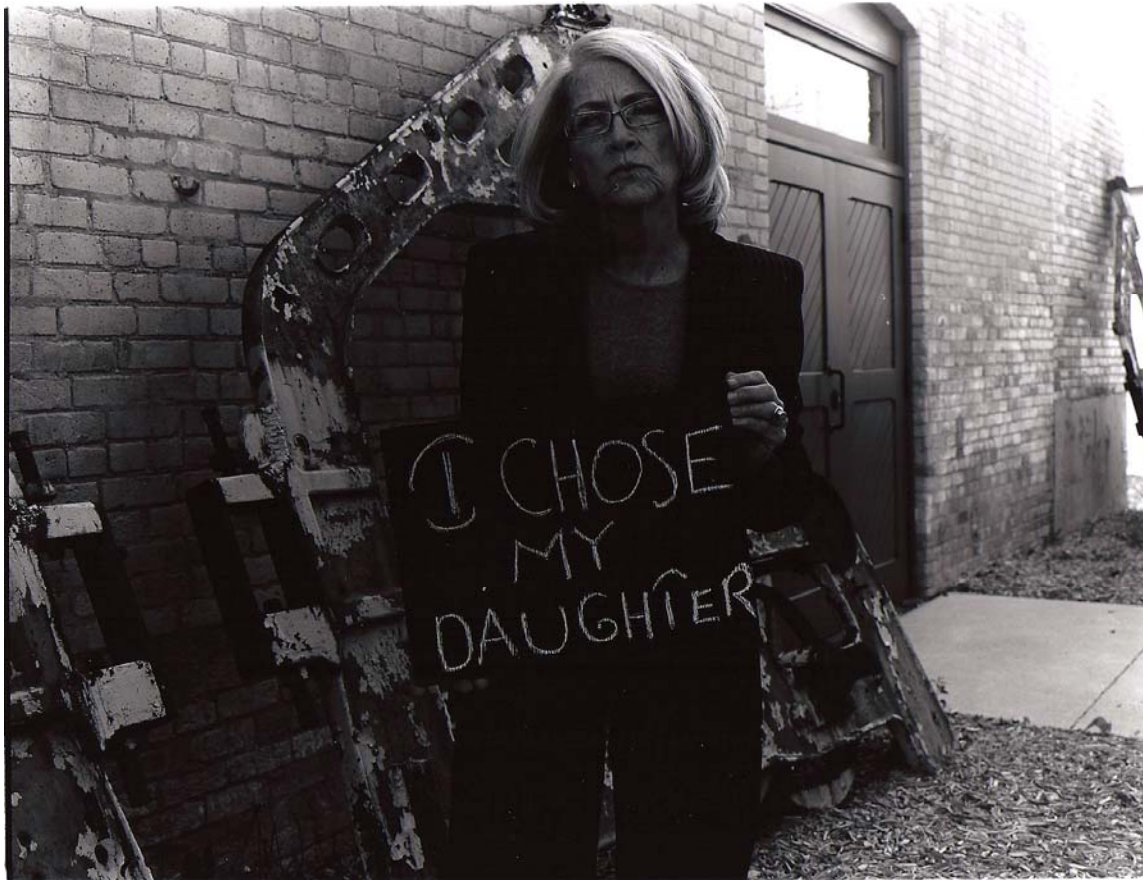


Highest two ratings include Moderate and Greatly.
