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INTRODUCTION

Introduction

Background and Objectives

At the request of the S & R Pieper Family Foundation, The Dieringer Research Group designed a research study regarding the needs of single parent families. The purpose of this study was to explore how individuals, living at or below a poverty existence, feel about the services that are available and whether or not the available services are meeting their needs.

The study was a three phase research project, designed to understand the issues facing single parents and to get feedback directly from those most involved and able to articulate their successes or concerns.

This report represents the information collected from the third and final phase of the research study, the Inventory of Social Service Agencies. This study was specifically conducted to inventory and profile the social service agencies operating in Milwaukee and determine the gaps in the services needed versus available to single parent families.

Methodology

In order to meet the study objectives, three separate, but inter-related, studies were conducted.

- Qualitative focus groups with single mothers (*one group currently using W-2 and one group who qualified but not currently using W-2*)
- 400 quantitative telephone interviews with single mothers (*200 currently using W-2 and 200 who qualify for W-2 but not currently using W-2*)
- A mail survey, designed to inventory social services agencies regarding the services available to persons in Milwaukee County

A mail questionnaire was distributed to the Executive Directors of 778 social service agencies in Milwaukee County. The mailing list included 747 organizations classified as a social service agency by Dun & Bradstreet Information Services (D&B) representing the SIC codes of: 8322 - Individual and Family Services (N=276), 8331 - Job Training and Related Services (N=36), 8351 - Child Day Care Services (N=357), and 8399 - Social Services not elsewhere classified (N=78). This list was supplemented by additional United Way agencies (N=21) and W-2 offices (N=10) not previously included in the D&B list.

Introduction

After the December 15, 2000 return deadline, the Executive Director of all organizations (except child day care organizations) was called to: qualify the organization as a social service agency directly serving individuals, confirm receipt of the questionnaire (a second questionnaire was sent if requested), and determine their plans to participate. The return deadline was then extended to January 15, 2001.

By the January 15, 2001 return deadline, 117 of the 654 qualified organizations¹ returned surveys, of which 102 returned usable, completed surveys². This is a response rate of 16%. This response rate is lower than anticipated, however, several factors may have affected the response rate. First of all, the study was conducted at the end of 2000/beginning of 2001, which is a busy time for social service organizations. Second, some respondents complained that they have received many questionnaires of this type and did not have the time to participate. Finally, through conversations with social service executives, it was confirmed that funding for many social service agencies has become outcome-based, resulting in pressures for this information and even mistrust toward the organizations/companies seeking this information.

¹ Out of the 778 organizations, 124 were not qualified due to: duplicate entries, a closed branch/location, no longer in existence, incorrectly classified by D&B, or was a trade association or organization. A qualified organization was defined as a social service organization providing services directly to individuals in Milwaukee County.

SUMMARY STATISTICS

Summary Statistics

Profile of Persons Served by Agency

- ◆ The majority of participating social service agencies generally served individuals of any gender, with some specializing in services for females only. Not one agency served males only.
- ◆ Just over one-third of participating agencies provided services to individuals of any age, while approximately one-fourth specialized in services directly for children. About one of six agencies served adults only.
- ◆ Approximately two-thirds of participating agencies served individuals of any income, while the remaining served only those with a low income level.

Summary Statistics

Profile of Participating Social Service Agencies

- ◆ The social service agencies participating in this study represent a good cross-section in terms of years in operation, ranging from less than 10 years to 30 or more years. The median number of years in operation of the participating agencies was 21 years.
- ◆ Within each of the 17 Neighborhood Strategic Planning Districts³ (NSP), approximately two-thirds of the participating agencies said they provide services to that NSP. This does not necessarily mean they served every NSP, although many agencies indicated they did.

Summary Statistics

Profile of Overall Results

The table on the next page illustrates a profile of the overall results⁴ for: the services offered, the median number of individuals served in 2000, the percent successful according to internal objective and goals, the median per person cost to provide the service, and the median expected to be able to serve in the future (assuming a consistent level of funds as in 2000)⁵.

- ◆ The most often provided services (offered by more than 20% of the participating agencies) were services for children/youth, child care/day care, food/clothing assistance, programs on self esteem, transportation, and mental/behavioral health counseling.
- ◆ Services pertaining to assisting individuals in job related efforts were only offered by 15% to 20% of participating organizations, however approximately three-fourths of the organizations offering these services felt they were successful in delivering each of these job-related services to the community. These success rates were among the highest for all the services outlined in the questionnaire. In addition, the median number of individuals organizations said they would be able to serve in the future was either consistent with or slightly more than the number served in 2000.
- ◆ Various types of counseling services or programs were offered, most often those for self esteem (27%), mental/behavioral health (23%), individual counseling (22%), and family counseling (21%). Other types of counseling offered less often were spouse/child abuse counseling (18%), alcohol/drug counseling (17%), assertiveness training (15%), and marriage counseling (12%).
- ◆ The services offered least often (less than 10% of responding organizations) were educational services, medical care, English language tutoring, sick child care, and legal assistance to ensure child support payments.
